Aleš Svatoš

Dr. Aleš Svatoš was born in Prague, Czech Republic. He obtained his Diploma (Chemistry) 1981, and PhD (Chemistry) 1985 at the Institute of Chemical Technology, Prague. Between 1986 and 1990, he became research associate at the Institute of Organic Chemistry and Biochemistry (IOCB) at the Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences in Prague. Between 1991-1993, he obtained a postdoctoral fellowship at Cornell University; and become a senior research associate at the IOCB, Czech Academy of Sciences, Prague, 1993-2002. Between 1997-1998, he obtained an Alexander von Humboldt Fellowship to carry out research in Germany.



Since 2002, he is the Group Leader of the Mass Spectrometry/Proteomics Research Group, Max-Planck-Institute for Chemical Ecology; and since 2013, he is an adjunct Professor at the IOCB, Czech Academy of Sciences, Prague. He has (co-)authored 235 scientific articles (h-index) 39.
