Dr. Bernd Schneider studied chemistry at the University of Halle/S., Germany (1973-1978). He did his doctoral studies at the same university (1978-1981). Later he became (1981 – 1990) an independent researcher to the Institute of Plant Biochemistry in the University of Halle/S (Germany). He was awarded an Alexander von Humboldt-Foundation fellowship to carry out his research at University of Munich (1991). Then, he returned – as a group leader – to the Institute of Plant Biochemistry in the University of Halle/S (1991-1997). In 1994, he got his habilitation at the University of Halle/S. (Germany)



Since 1997, he is the head of the research group "Biosynthesis / NMR" at the Max-Planck-Institute for Chemical Ecology Jena (Germany). Where he pursues, his research interests focused in natural products chemistry and biosynthesis, chemical ecology, NMR spectroscopy. Bernd has (co-)authored 285 publications
