Over this time, he has achieved designations as a Certified Facility Manager by the International Facility Management Association (IFMA), and a LEED Associate Professional by the US Green Building Council (USGBC).

Dave currently serves on the IFMA South Florida Chapter as Immediate Past President and is former Board member of the IFMA National Research and Development Council.
